Greetings ! We hope you'll be coming out to enjoy the park's beauty and peacefulness and the Jersey City free **Summerfest** concerts. These diverse shows with jazz, rhythm and blues, some rock, and country, will take place on Tuesdays from 7 to 9 pm, and at a new time on Sundays, 5 to 7 pm. Again this year, they will take place on the eastern side of Liberty House Restaurant. Park in the ferry lot on Zapp Drive for free after 4 pm. Bring your family and friends and picnics.

We especially appeal to your generosity this year. In addition to your usual annual contribution, please help us pay our legal costs in our fight to preserve the sacred NYC views and the Public Plaza. We were forced to start the law case because the Governor ignored the clear, strong voice of park users opposing the hill and walls 9/11 Memorial.

The park is looking great. The **Friends Garden Program volunteers**, under the guidance of Maria de Wakefield, LSP's now full-time, knowledgeable horticulturist, have made a real difference in the number and quality of the park's gardens. Friendly volunteers come to pitch in every Sat. from 8 am to 11 am, rain or shine, and **everyone, with no experience necessary, is always welcome.** The Friends funded **\$10,000 of trees** this Spring, with the cooperation of the NJ Tree Foundation (NJTF) which selected, delivered and planted the trees. **The new wetland** with a pond and paths behind the Interpretive Center (where chromium was removed) will open in Fall.

The Friends volunteers were augmented last Fall by the NJ City University students of Dr. Cindy Arrigo and by the volunteers of the **Rutgers Master Gardeners Class**, which starts again at LSP in September.
