Girl Scouts Love State Parks Shoreline Cleanup

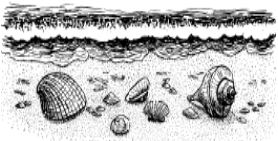
Saturday, September 9th 10:00 AM – Noon

Located along the Atlantic Flyway, Liberty State Park is home to over 250 different species of birds. Join us as we explore varied habitats and learn to identify some of our resident and migratory birdlife. Please dress to be outside and bring binoculars if you have them. We have a limited number that can be borrowed. We will meet at the Nature Center located at 275 Freedom Way. **Recommended for ages 5 & up.**
