Saturday, April 6th 11:00 AM - 2:00 PM (rain date Sunday, April 7th)

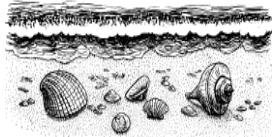

Saturday, April 20th 12:00 PM - 2:00 PM

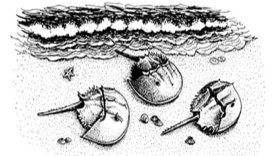
