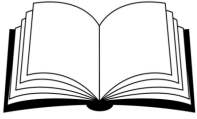


September Nature Programs at Liberty State Park

1:00 PM - 3:00 PM

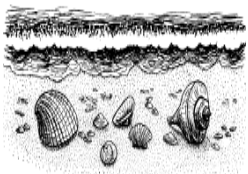
